ADJECTIVES THAT COMPARE

Adjectives can describe by comparing. One-syllable adjectives usually add er or est to make comparisons. Use er to compare two persons or things. Use est to compare more than two persons or things.

Days on the farm seemed duller than days in the city.

The first few days were the slowest of Tom's life.

Adjectives with two or more syllables usually use *more* or *most* to make comparisons.

The city was *more interesting* to tom than the country.

The farm was the **most boring** place in the world.
