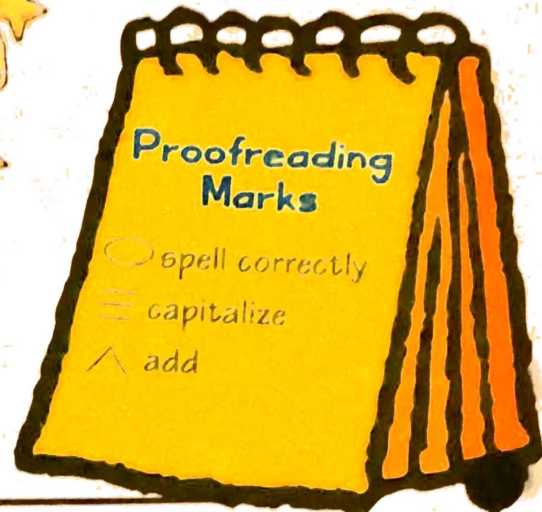

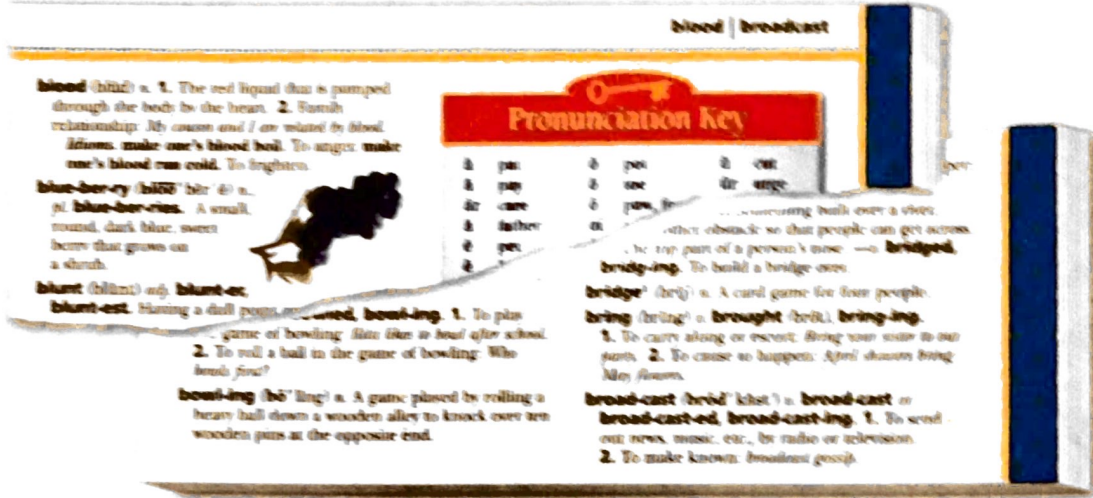
All the Right Moves
