

Dictionary Skills

Using the Spelling Table

If you need to look up a word in a dictionary but aren't sure how to spell it, a spelling table can help. A spelling table lists common spellings for sounds. Suppose you are not sure how the first vowel sound in August is spelled. First, look in the table to find the pronunciation symbol for the sound. Then read the first spelling listed for /ô/, and look up Agust in a dictionary. Look for each spelling in the dictionary until you find the correct one.
